At home, you could look at old and new photos and discuss what is different about them. You could talk to grandparents about how life and times have changed and some of the new technology that they didn't have when growing up.

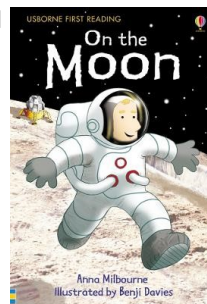
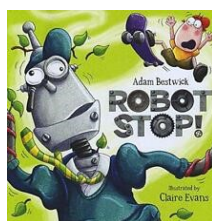
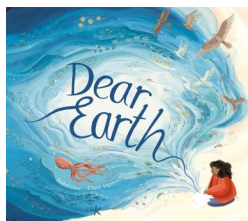
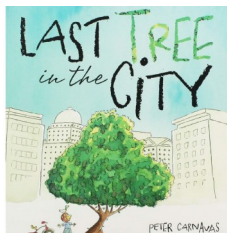
Our thinking skills for the term are “working together and investigating”

English: In Literacy, we will be reading books that reflect modern times. If your child has a favourite book please share it with the class. The books from this topic will be both fiction and non fiction.

Science: In Science we will be exploring different materials, what they are made from and how they change shape. We will be bending, stretching, squashing and pulling and observing the changes that occur. If you are cooking at home, discuss any ingredients that change as you cook them, for example eggs. Take photos, what do you notice?

Music: Disco or Indie kid?! We will be listening to music across the decades. From wholesome family music of the 1950's, to funky disco beats from the 1970's, girl and boy bands of the 90's and Brit pop. Does your son/daughter have a preference for music from a certain decade? Listen to different music and discuss at home.

History: Pupils will be looking at important people from beyond living memory who have contributed to the communities around them, and society as a whole. Florence Nightingale revolutionised healthcare and the running of hospitals by emphasizing the importance of hand washing, a healthy diet and exercise, and Dr Barnardo ensured that the most needy children in Victorian society had a bed, food and access to education.

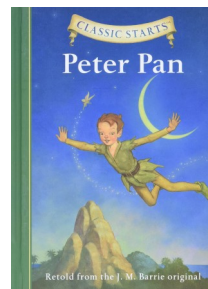
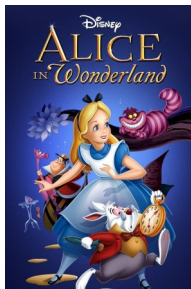
